

Quick Start: How to Set Up the G-mee Co-pilot

A. On the G-mee Connect Pro or G-mee Play Pro

- Set up basic settings: language, date, time, and screen lock - Accept Google's terms and conditions - Connect to a Wi-Fi Network	Update your G-mee device to the latest software version. Go to <i>Settings > System > System Update > Check for Update > Update > Restart</i>	- Allow Permissions for: Accessibility, Device and app notifications. Open the G-mee App > Scan QR to allow the permissions. - Set permission for Location as "allow all the time" - Allow Usage Access. Go to <i>Settings > Apps > Special App Access Usage Access</i> *Use 2023 as the default G-mee PIN. Please reset the PIN after set up	- Open the G-mee App - Tap "Scan QR" and scan the QR code from the Co-pilot app on your phone (guardian's phone) to connect
			

B. On your own smartphone

1 Download the G-mee Co-Pilot App Install the app on your phone to start managing the G-mee Connect Pro or G-mee Play Pro remotely.  Get it on Google Play  Get it on the App Store 	2 Sign Up for a Co-Pilot Account After installing the app, create a Co-Pilot account 
3 Approve Permissions on the G-mee Device Please follow the instructions for the G-mee device as outlined in section A.3. 	4 Scan the QR code on the G-mee device - After creating a Co-Pilot Account, select Remote Device Controls - Tap "Add G-mee Device" - Scan the QR code on the G-mee Device
